ALMAdebate

Limits is a value-based working method dealing with rights and obligations based on the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. To increase the comprehension and awareness of the child, we will connect to issues in their everyday lives. The concept aims at increasing children's possibilities to have their own opinion, to be active and to realize their responsibility. Limits offers lectures for school classes with active exercises and seminars for teachers and other school personnel.
